Classes

286 Hand-tied bouquet 'A Disney character'.

Create a hand-tied bouquet inspired by a Disney character. Fresh materials to be used and any trims or accessories may be included. To be displayed in the entrants own container, with a card indicating the character. The allocated area for this design is 50cm x 50cm with no height restriction. This class is for those with less than three years' experience.

287 Wedding bouquet 'For a leading lady of stage or screen'.

Design a **formal** bouquet (wired or in a medium) inspired by a leading lady. Fresh materials and accessories may be incorporated into your design. A bouquet stand will be provided and the display area for the design is 50cm x 50cm with no height restriction. Please place a card next to the design explaining who the leading lady is.

288 Interpretative arrangement 'On location'.

An interpretative arrangement to depict a film set location. Fresh materials and accessories may be used to assist the interpretation. An area of 60cm x 60cm with no height restriction will be allocated for the design. A card to be placed next to the design stating the chosen location and film.

- 289 Wall hanging ‘Memorable children’s TV show’**
Create a wall hanging inspired by a memorable children’s TV show, using dried, preserved or fabric material. Other accessories may be included. A secure method of hanging must be used. A card stating the title of the TV show to be placed next to the design. An allocated display area of 50cm x 50cm will be included.
- 290 Wired/glued accessory ‘Favourite villain of stage or screen’.**
Design a wired/glued accessory inspired by a stage or screen villain (male or female). Fresh, artificial and dried materials may be used. A card indicating where the design is to be worn and who the villain is to be placed next to the accessory. An area of 40cm x 40cm will be allocated without height restriction.
- 291 Floor standing display ‘West End Production’.**
Open to floral organisations, floristry businesses and individuals. Construct a display to depict a West End production. The floor area to be no larger than 90cm x 90cm with no height restriction to provide the perfect platform for you to show high quality design work. Any flower props and materials may be used within the allocated area.
The winner of this class will be awarded the Carey PCC trophy.

Competition rules

1. Entries close on Friday 21st April 2017.
2. There is no restriction on the number of entries submitted.
3. Exhibitors must place their entries between 2.30pm and 7.30pm on Sunday 28th May, or before 9am on Monday 29th May. Please see note below regarding vehicles on the show ground.
4. All entries are accepted at the risk of the contestant. The organisers will not be liable for loss or damage to an exhibit.
5. Background drapes/niches can be provided by the contestant if desired.
6. Designs must be contained within the area specified. Overlapping will result in disqualification.
7. Any entries not conforming to the schedule will be disqualified prior to judging.
8. Judging will take place between 9.00am and 11.00am on Monday 29th May. 'Public's choice' judging will be open throughout the day until 4pm, when counting will take place.
9. The judges' decision is final.

Please note: Exhibitors will be supplied with a **yellow delivery label**. This must be attached to the windscreen of the vehicle making a delivery on Show Day, which **must depart the ground by 9.00am**. The driver of the vehicle need not hold an admission ticket, but will need to pay a £50 cash deposit at the yellow entrance, for which they will be given a receipt. This amount will be returned in full on leaving the show ground at the London Road exit only before 9.00am. If the driver leaves after 9.00am the deposit will be forfeited. Passengers must either have admission tickets or pay on entrance.

Parking is free in the main visitor car park (turn left when you exit the ground).

Each exhibitor will receive one free ticket to the Show. Additional tickets can be purchased at the following discounted rate via the floristry entry form.
